49 academic papers were accepted as the refereed conference papers by TLOG-ISC and presented in the 5th TLOG conference. In addition, 18 practical presentations were given in the 5th TLOG conference. Among all accepted academic papers, “OCDI Takeuchi Yoshio Award for Logistics Research” was awarded to a paper “An Exploratory Study on Ship Dwell Time in International Ports,” which was written by Dr. Ghim Ping ONG and Mr. Lu YIN (National University of Singapore). Also, OCDI Logistics Award for Young Researchers were also given to Dr. Mingyao QI (Tsinghua University) for his paper entitled “A Mobile Facility Routing Problem with Service-time-related Demands” and Ms. Angkana Leelakulkietchai (King Mongkut’s Institute of Technology Ladkrabang) for her paper entitled “A Reference Model of the Distribution Center in Hospital Supply Chain.”
